Aged Resident Dead

Mrs. Sarah G. Rice, widow of George C. Rice, who was at one time superintendent of the treasury, died this morning at the advanced age of 92 years. Mrs. Rice was born in England, April 2, 1815. She had been a resident of this city for the past forty years.

One son, Mr. C.A. Rice of Vienna, Va., and two daughters, Mrs. A.K. Williams and Miss Kate Rice of 1000 Maryland avenue northeast, besides a number of grandchildren, survive her.
