F.J. Richardson, Sr., Father of Mayor

Frederick J. Richardson, sr., 80, father of Frederick J. Richardson, jr., Mayor of Mount Rainier, Md., died Tuesday at the home of his son, 3811 Thirty-seventh street, Mount Rainier. Mr. Richardson had lived with his son for the past two years.

A native of Washington, Mr. Richardson lived most of his life in the Southwest area of the city. He was employed by the old Washington Railway & Electric Co. and later was a purchasing agent with the old Washington, Baltimore & Annapolis Railroad. He has been retired about 20 years.

Besides his son in Mount Rainier, he is survived by another son, Dr. Francis X. Richardson, 7177 Alaska avenue N.W.; a daughter, Miss Mary C. Richardson of Washington; a sister, 11 grandchildren and 7 great-grandchildren.
