John Phillip Rick, 76, retired interior decorator and native of Washington, died yesterday at the John Dickson Home, 5000 Fourteenth street. Funeral services will be held at 10 a.m. tomorrow from the Hines funeral chapel, 2901 Fourteenth street. Burial with Masonic honors will be in Congressional Cemetery.

Mr. Rick for many years was manager and buyer for the W.B. Moses & Sons Co. He directed the decoration of several public buildings, hotels and residences in Washington. He was a member of the B.B. French Lodge, No. 15, F.A.A.M.; Brotherhood of St. Andrew, Textile Trade Associations and Board of Trade.

He is survived by his son, Ernest P. Rick of Washington, and a brother, Robert Andrew Rick of Maryland Park, Md.
