Mrs. Ernest C. Rick, D.C. School Teacher 35 Years, Dies at 57

Mrs. Ernest Charles Rick, 57, a District public school teacher for the last 35 years, died yesterday afternoon at Sibley Hospital after an emergency operation.

Mrs. Rick, who lived at 1335 Massachusetts avenue S.E., was to have retired June 30.

A mathematics and geography teacher at Hine Junior High School until her recent illness, she also taught in most of the Southeast schools. In addition to day school, Mrs. Rick taught night journalism classes for 18 years at Eastern McKinley and Western High Schools.

Mrs. Rick was born in the District. She was a graduate of Eastern High School and of the Washington Normal School. Her later education included Teachers' college at University of Chicago and Oxford University, England, supplement with wide educational travel in the British Isles and in Europe.

Her first teaching assignment was at the Grant Elementary School. During the last three summers, Mrs. Rick was associated with the Marshall Field Enterprises as an educational counselor and representative. She recently had announced plans for making a book of a diary she had kept throughout her career. She is survived by her husband, who taught in the public schools here for 25 years. The couple had no children.

Funeral services will be held at 10 a.m. Saturday at her residence. Burial will be in Congressional Cemetery.
