Funeral

Yesterday afternoon the members of Osage Tribe, No. 6, I.O.R.M., assembled at their Lodge Room in Druid Hall on D street, between 6th and 7th to pay their final tribute of respect to the remains of a deceased brother, Mordecai Ridgeway. The members assembled in force and wore the regalia of their Order. The Rev. Mr. McCea, Assistant Minister of St. John's Episcopal Church, conducted the burial services of the Episcopal Church at the Lodge Room, and afterwards at the grave in Congressional Cemetery, after which the members of the Tribe performed the funeral rites of their Order. The Red Men were headed by Professor Weber's Germania Band.
