Dr. Riley, Native of Montgomery, Is Buried Here

Dr. Benjamin Price Riley, 70, New York physician and a native of Montgomery County, who died Saturday at his home, 5 Greenlawn N.Y., was buried Tuesday in Congressional Cemetery.

Dr. Riley was born on his family's estate, Gerhom near Norbeck, Md. And was graduated from the University of Virginia in 1902. He was lineal descendant of Sir William Blackstone, English legal authority and Edmund Searbotham, first surveyor general of Virginia. His parents were Philander C. and Virginia S. Riley.

Surviving are his wife Mrs. J___ Marlborough Riley, of Greenlawn, two sons, Benjamin Price Riley jr., also of Greenlawn and Page M. Riley, National Guard private at Fort Dix: two daughters, Virginia S. Riley and Julia M. Riley of Greenlawn: three sisters, Elizabeth Ellen and Harriet Riley of Norbeck and a brother, Lieut. Col. Philander C. _____ of Fayetteville, N.C.
