## **Child Dies of Lockjaw**

## Injury to Five-Year-Old Boy's Face Proves Fatal

Coroner Nevitt was informed this morning of the death yesterday afternoon of William Robertson, five years old, whose parents live at 1500 Gales street. The child died at the Children's Hospital of tetanus, following an injury he received to his face May 29. He was playing in the street with a number of companions and was accidentally struck with a small branch of a tree.
