Columbus Robey, who had resided in this part of the District for a number of years, died at 12 o'clock Saturday last at the home of relatives on Naylor road, Twining City, following an illness of several years' duration, the result of paralysis. Mr. Robey was a member of John A. Logan Post, No. 13, Grand Army of the Republic, of Anacostia. He is survived by several children.

The funeral was held this afternoon from the chapel in Congressional cemetery, where Rev. Charles O. Isaac, pastor of the Anacostia Methodist Episcopal Church, conducted the last rites. Senior Vice Commander H.W. Eno of Logan Post designated the following members to act as pallbearers: Alpheus Davison, James H. Dony, Thomas J. Putnam and D.K. Watson.
