Auto Overturns, Md. Man Killed

A 76-year-old Takoma Park man was killed Sunday when he was thrown from a car that overturned two miles east of Leesburg on Rte. 7, according to Virginia State Police.

The man, identified as Wilmore L. Rollins, of 7667 Maple Ave., Takoma Park, was a passenger in a car driven by his wife, Eva Mae, 59, police said. Mrs. Rollins suffered only bruises in the accident, according to police, but was being held last night for observation at Leesburg Hospital.

Police said Mrs. Rollins apparently lost control of the car, which went off the road's shoulder and overturned several times.
