### **Man Hit by Boy's Bicycle Dies**

Charles Ross, 67, of 535 Yuma st. se., died yesterday at Hadley Memorial Hospital, apparently of head injuries he suffered when struck by a bicycle Saturday night, Metropolitan Police reported.

Police Pvt. John C. Gill, of the 11th Precinct, said he was off duty and en route home when he saw Ross knocked down at 4th and Atlantic sts. se. by a bicycle ridden by a 16-year-old youth, who fell from his bike but was uninjured.

Gill said the youth told him that he did not see Ross until it was "too late." Ross, an employe of the YMCA at 18th and G sts. nw., was crossing 4th st. with a bag of groceries in his arms, Gill said. The youth was placed in the Receiving Home pending a coroner's inquest at 11 a.m. today at the District Morgue.
