The Funeral of the Late George Washington Rothwell, son of Mr. Andrew Rothwell, took place yesterday afternoon from the E street Baptist church. The services were conducted by Rev. Dr. Jutten and Rev. C.C. Meador. The remains were followed from the church by a large number of the relatives and friends of the deceased, the choir, Sunday school teachers, and the Choral society, to the Congressional Cemetery, where the interment took place, the Choral society singing a dirge at the grave and Rev. Mr. Meador pronouncing the benediction. The services were very impressive. The singing of the Choral society, particularly at the grave, made a profound impression on those present, which was not lessened by the solemnity of the funeral music of the choir. The remarks of the Rev. Dr. Jutten were well calculated to impress the lessons of mortality and immortality upon the minds of his hearers.
