Fatal Accident

On Friday morning, as a train of cars on Maryland avenue was crossing 12th street, a cart, driven by a boy named Charles Wesley Rundell, was struck, causing it to tilt, and he fell out, the wheel of the cart passing over him. He walked to his residence corner 13 1/2 and D streets, and Dr. Croggon called, who pronounced him to be seriously injured internally, and notwithstanding the attention given him he died in about two hours.
