Mrs. Pauline F. Russell Dies At Age Of 82 Years

Widow of Washington Physician to Be Buried

From Home Tomorrow Afternoon

Mrs. Pauline Fleury Russell, 82 years old, widow of Dr. William R. Russell and a lifelong resident of this city, died at her home, 1832 Biltmore street, early today after a long illness.

Mrs. Russell was born November 13, 1847. Her husband was a prominent physician here.

Funeral services will be conducted at the residence tomorrow afternoon at 3 o'clock. Mrs. Russell's son-in-law, Rev. William O. Roome of Philadelphia, will officiate. Interment will be private, in Congressional Cemetery.

Mrs. Russell is survived by three sons, Eugene L. Russell, Percy H. Russell and John L. Russell, all of this city, and two daughters, Miss Mabel L. Russell of this city and Mrs. William O. Roome of Philadelphia.
