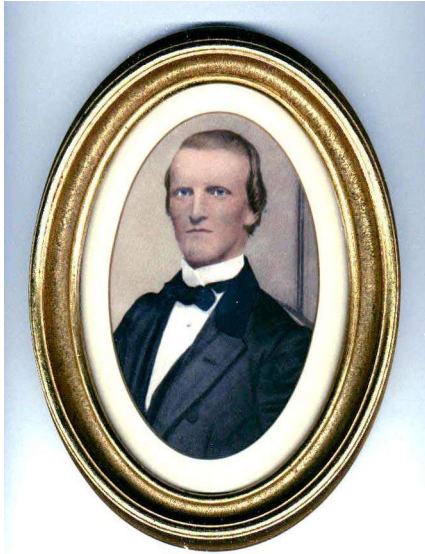


Frank T. Sands

Frank T. Sands, Esq., long known as an undertaker in this city, and who was during the war employed by the Government in that capacity, died at his residence in East Washington on Saturday evening and was buried in Mt. Olivet cemetery this morning.
