### **Hunt For 2 Youths In Slaying Stalled**

#### **Two Cottages on Potomac River Near Glen Echo Raided by Homicide Squad**

Police were at a standstill today in their quest for two youths wanted in connection with the killing of George Edward Sanford, 20, of 1213 K street S.E.

Detective Lt. George E. Darnall, chief of the homicide squad, acting on a tip, led raids yesterday on two cottages on the Potomac River near Glen Echo, Md., but found no evidence of the fugitives.

Sanford's body, the heart pierced by a bullet, was left at Children's Hospital early Saturday by two youths who still are at large, despite an extensive police search. The mother of one of them has appealed to him to surrender.
