May Schneider, 90, a lifelong resident of Washington, D.C., died yesterday of a stroke, at her home at the Cairo Hotel, 1615 Q st. nw.

Miss Schneider was the sister of the late T. Franklin Schneider, one of the pioneer apartment builders of Washington and the builder of the Cairo Hotel, Washington's first steel "skyscraper."

Miss Schneider was born at Four Corners, Md., and was a lifelong member of the First Baptist Church. She had been a shut-in for the past five years.
