Flora Schuldt, Retired VA Aide

Flora C. Schuldt, 91, a lifelong resident of the Washington area, died Sunday at Suburban Hospital in Bethesda.

Born in Washington, she had lived for many years on Capitol Hill. She was the sister of the late Judge Gus Schuldt, of the old Municipal Court.

Miss Schuldt, a graduate of McKinley High School, had studied at the old Prof. Henry Thierback School of Music here and taught piano for a number of years.

She was employed as a researcher by the Veterans Administration from 1918 until retiring in 1948.

She had been a member of Temple Chapter 13 of the Eastern Star since 1909. She also had been a member of Capitol Hill Presbyterian Church for more than 77 years.

At the time of her death, she was a resident of Kensington Gardens.

There are no immediate survivors.
