Wants A Divorce

On behalf of Clara Seymour, Attorneys Fulton and Edwards have filed a petition for divorce from Eben E. Seymour. The parties were married in New York December 1891, removing to this city two years later. Mrs. Seymour charges her husband with desertion and with living with one Ida Maud Wynne, at 1107 10th street, where he represented, she asserts, that the woman was his daughter. Mrs. Seymour also charges her husband with disposing of her furniture and jewelry, and in addition to the decree of divorce, asks that the sum of \$97 be allowed her, and also alimony, and that her husband be restrained from interfering with her in any way.
