Miss Iola Grace Shaffer, 67, died Tuesday night in Garfield Memorial Hospital after a long illness.

Miss Shaffer lived at 107 East Melbourne avenue, Silver Spring, with a sister, Mrs. Maude R. Crown.

Born in the District, she was graduated from the old Business High School in 1899. She immediately began work with the old Philadelphia Market and remained with the firm until her retirement in 1938 as manager and bookkeeper. The market was on Connecticut avenue across from the Mayflower Hotel.
