#### **Jesse M. Shreve Dies Suddenly In Hospital**

##### **Veteran Publicity Agent and Newspaper Man Victim of Recurring Illness**

Jesse M. (Harry) Shreve, 51 years old, veteran publicity agent for local theaters and member of the reviewing staff of the Washington Herald and Times, died yesterday at Providence Hospital. A sudden recurrence of an illness suffered two months ago caused his death.

Besides serving on every local newspaper, Mr. Shreve also had been connected with large publications throughout the country. He had also been a contributor to many magazines.

As a dramatic critic and publicity agent, he was long associated with theatrical activity in Washington. Recently he was publicist for the Mutual Burlesque Theaters.

He is survived by his mother, Mrs. Sarah Shreve; two sisters, Mrs. Charles Lyons and Mrs. L. Dickinson, and two brothers, Samuel R. and William H. Shreve, all of Washington. The Shreve residence is at 223 B street southeast.

Funeral services will be held Saturday afternoon at 2 o'clock at the Zurhorst funeral parlors. Burial will be in the Congressional Cemetery.
