Rites For Mrs. Henry Slye

Funeral Services Will Be Held in St. Peter's Tomorrow

Mrs. Henry Slye, 72 years old, mother of John Queen Slye, for many years a member of the White House secret service died Friday at her home, 212 A street southeast.

Funeral services will be held in St. Peter's church Monday at 10 a.m.

Mrs. Slye's father, John Randolph Queen, was a widely known resident here and her grandfather was Thomas Moore, prominently identified with the early history of Washington, and one time editor of the Washington Herald.

Surviving are her son and a brother, John Forney Slye, both of whom lived with her.

Private interment will be in Congressional cemetery.
