Lifelong Washington Resident Succumbs at Age of 83

Mrs. Mary E. Smallwood 83, a lifelong resident of Washington, died yesterday at the home of her son, L. Vernon Smallwood, 1603 Lincoln road northeast, after a long illness.

She was the oldest member of Trinity Methodist Episcopal Sunday school, having joined at the age of 5.
