Corporal Henry O. Smiley, company E, 1st Maine heavy artillery, died on the 25th inst. at Armory Hospital of wounds received in the battle of the Wilderness. A diploma from Rising Virtue Lodge, F.A.A.M., of Maine, was found upon his person. He was buried by Washington Naval Lodge, No. 4, F.A.A.M., yesterday afternoon at Congressional Cemetery, in the ground of the Grand Lodge of this District, with all the honors of Masonry.
