Betty H. Smith, 48, who returned to college to get a graduate degree in library sciences, died Tuesday night at Alexandria Hospital after a heart attack.

She lived at 8029 Wellington rd., Alexandria, with her husband, John Philip Smith Jr., and their two children. Mrs. Smith graduated in 1936 from the National Cathedral School for Girls and in 1940 from the University of Maryland. She returned to school this year to take graduate courses in library sciences.

Mrs. Smith served on the Board of Lady Managers for Alexandria Hospital, was director of the Altar Guild of St. Luke's Episcopal Church and president of the garden section of the Women's Club of Belle Haven.
