Mrs. Smith, who was born in Portsmouth, Va., was the widow of Samuel Smith, who was for ten years commander of Rawlins Post, No. 1, G.A.R., and a corporal in Morgan's Company, 6th Battalion, District of Columbia Volunteers, during the civil war. She leaves one son and eight grandchildren, Walter Smith, Frank Smith, Robert Smith, Samuel O. Burdette, Margaret Smith, Catherine Smith, Florence Smith and Annie Smith.
