Dropped Dead in Baltimore

Mr. E.A. Smith, who is well known in this city, dropped dead yesterday afternoon at the corner of North and Bradish avenues, Baltimore. He was employed as foreman for the contractor who was building a row of houses at that place and had just returned from dinner, and was in the act of giving some instructions to one of the workmen when he fell over. Several men ran to his assistance, but they found that he was dead. The remains were removed to his home in Baltimore and tomorrow will be brought to this city for interment. The deceased was 63 years of age, and leaves a widow and a grown son.
