During the Civil War residence in Washington was not safe for Confederate sympathizers,
consequently Mrs. Smoot leased her residence and retired to her mother's plantation in Prince Georges
County, Maryland. The leasee sub-let to the Federal Government which housed from time to time in the
21-room mansion thousands of ex-slaves. And true to the race they destroyed entirely the hand-carved
wood work, the frescoing, and other interior features for which the house was noted. Mrs. Smoot lived
to celebrate her eightieth birthday and departed on July 8, 1901
