Mr. Sniffin for many years conducted a notion store at 704 11th street southeast, residing during the time at 1101 G street southeast. When a young man he was in the United States Marine Corps. He was a member of the Fourth Street Methodist Episcopal Church. Mr. Sniffin's second wife was the daughter of Jacob Bohlayer, one of Napoleon's soldiers at Waterloo.
