### **Death of Charles Somerset**

#### **Served for More Than Forty Years in U.S. Army**

Charles Somerset, a veteran of the United States Army, died early yesterday morning at his home, 1823 Union street southwest.

Mr. Somerset was born in Ireland sixty-eight years ago and came to the United States when he was eight years old. When he became of age he enlisted in the United States Army and served for more than forty years.

About thirty years ago, while he was stationed at the Washington barracks, Mr. Somerset became one of the honorary members of the Sons of Jonadab and during the rest of his life took an active interest in the work of that organization. His wife, Mrs. Alice Somerset, survives him.

Funeral services will be held at his late residence at 2 o'clock tomorrow afternoon. The services will be in charge of the Sons of Jonadab. Interment will be in Congressional cemetery.
