Samuel Sowerbutts Succumbs In Hospital

Was Resident of National Capital for Thirty-Five Years

Samuel Sowerbutts, thirty-five years a resident of this city, died yesterday afternoon at Casualty Hospital, where he underwent an operation Saturday. He had been ill more than a year, but had been able to attend to his business most of the time. Saturday morning his condition became so critical that it was decided to take him to the hospital and have an operation performed as a last resort. Mrs. Sowerbutts and other members of the family were at the bedside when death came.

The deceased was born in Preston, England, sixty-two years ago. He came to this country thirty-six years ago, and remained in Massachusetts several months before coming to this city.

Until about six years ago Mr. Sowerbutts was engaged in the insurance business. Lately he was interested in several realty companies. He was a member of Iris Lodge, Shield of Honor, and was connected with the Iris Realty Company and the City and County Improvement Association. Mr. Sowerbutts had been one of the most active members of the Northeast Washington Citizens' Association, and had served as its secretary a number of years.

He is survived by his wife and five children, Robert P., Richard C., Samuel W., Miss Laura G. and Miss Margaret E. Sowerbutts.

The body was taken to the family home at 1849 Good Hope road, Anacostia, last night. Funeral services will be conducted at the family home tomorrow afternoon at 2 o'clock. Interment will be at Congressional cemetery.
