### **Daniel J. Spalding Dies**

#### **Long-Time Resident of Southwest Washington, Born in 1833**

Daniel J. Spalding, one of the oldest residents of southwest Washington in his 85th year died last night at his home from a complication of diseases. Funeral services are to be held at 2 o'clock Thursday afternoon. Interment will be in Congressional Cemetery.

Mr. Spalding was born in Baltimore, August 2, 1833 and came to Washington in 1851. He had been employed in the navy yard here for 52 years.

He is survived by his wife, Mrs. Mary Spalding and by two sons and two daughters, John H. Spalding and Mrs. Maggie Berry of this city and Daniel J. Spalding, jr. and Mrs. Kate Weeber of Philadelphia.
