Drops Dead

William H. Speiser Fatally Stricken on the Street

William H. Speiser, a painter, twenty seven years old, who lived at 1107 M street southeast, dropped dead Saturday afternoon. He was talking to friends at 11th and M streets, only a few doors from his home, when he was stricken.

A physician who reached the unfortunate man only a few minutes after he fell pronounced life extinct. His body was removed to his late home and a certificate of death from natural causes was given. The deceased, who leaves a wife and two children, was recently employed on the work of decorating the interior of St. Aloysius Church.
