Maurice Spencer Dies; Was 35 Years With U.S.

Burial Will Take Place in Congressional Cemetery Tomorrow Afternoon

Maurice Spencer, 58 years old, for 35 years an employe of the Government Printing Office, died suddenly at his residence, 633 M street northeast, Saturday night. Burial will be in Congressional Cemetery tomorrow afternoon at 2 o'clock.

Born at Crystal Springs, Miss., Mr. Spencer came to Washington in 1893 to accept a position as printer at the Government Printing Office. Since then he held numerous positions, from compositor to assistant foreman of the hand composing section. At the time of his death, Mr. Spencer was employed as proofreader in the day proof section. He was a member of Columbia Typographical Union, No. 101, of this city.

He leaves his wife, Mrs. Ida M. Spencer; a brother, Hewlett Abbey Spencer of Tulsa, Okla. And a sister, Mrs. R.H. Howell of Crystal Springs.
