## SPINNER, LOUIS P.

Painter born in Pennsylvania (possibly Warren) in 1851/52, he was active in DC from as early as 1880 until at least 1914, though he was still a resident in 1924, when he is mentioned in the obituary of a former student, Louis H. Gebhart. His portrait of Joseph Holt, who was Secretary of War for a brief priod in 1861, is in the Collection of the U.S. Army's Portrait Gallery. Another work by him, "The First Smoke" (1870) was offered for sale by a Marlow Heights, MD, gallery in 1917. His "The Fish Dinner" was included in the exhibition still Lifes and Nature studies from the George J.
