Thomas B. Stallings Dies

Brother of Former Alabama Representative Expires at Home Here

Thomas Broughton Stallings, former clerk to Senator Johnston of Alabama, and brother to former Representative J.T. Stallings of Alabama, died yesterday at his home, 640 Rock Creek Church road. Funeral arrangements are not to be made until the arrival here of former Representative Stallings, who is expected tomorrow morning.

In addition to his brother, his mother, and a sister, Mrs. A. Armstrong, survive Mr. Stallings. He was born in Greenville, Ala., in 1871, and was educated in private schools in that state.

He held a position in the navy yard here, following which he was made a clerk in the bureau of navigation. Later he became clerk to the Senate committee on military affairs.
