Funeral of James Stockett

The funeral of the late James Stockett took place yesterday from the residence of his brother, No. 313 F street northeast. Deceased, who was about forty years old, was well-known here in business circles. He was a son of the late Wesley A. Stockett and brother of Messrs. Stockett Bros., bookbinders. In his earlier days he learned the trade of bookbinding, and for a number of years conducted business in Baltimore. He returned to this city, and was employed in the government printing office. Later he went into the real estate business, in which he remained until the time of his death. The deceased lived on Capitol Hill most of his life, where he had a host of friends.

The funeral services were conducted by Rev. Mr. Williams of Christ Episcopal Church, Navy Yard. The body was interred in Congressional Cemetery.
