William Edward Stockett, 82, manufacturing stationer, died yesterday at his home, 3901 Morrison street N.W., after a long illness.

A native of this city, Mr. Stockett founded the business now known as the Stockett-Fiske Co., serving as its president until his death.

Interested in boating, he was a former vice commodore and for many years a member of the Corinthian Yacht Club. In 1934 he was elected an honorary life member. He was a member of the Elks Club and in his earlier days of the old Capital Bicycle Club and the Columbia Fishing Club.
