W.F. Stone, Retired Transit Worker, Dies

William F. Stone, 65, retired Capital Transit Co. draftsman, died yesterday at Sibley Hospital after an illness of two years. He lived at 501 Montana avenue N.E.

Mr. Stone retired January 1, 1948, after 42 years' service with Capital Transit and its predecessor, the Washington Railway & Electric Co.

Born near Cincinnati, Mr. Stone came here in 1906. He was a member of the Quarter Century Club of the transit company and the Lincoln Road Methodist Church.
