STRICKLAND, GEORGE

Artist born in Philadelphia, PA, in 1797, he studied art under his brother William. He was active in Philadelphia until about 1835, exhibiting at the Pennsylvania Academy of Fine Arts. He moved to DC about 1835 and died there in 1851. His pencil drawing of the "Capitol, Washington" (1837) was included in the exhibition Washington on the Potomac at the Corcoran Gallery of Art in 1982. It is in the Corcoran's collection.
