John Sweetman, widely known in business circles of Washington for many years, died at his home, 729 22d street northwest, of Bright's disease, Wednesday morning. Funeral services will be held at the residence tomorrow afternoon, at 3 o'clock, with interment at Congressional cemetery, Rev. Dr. Robert Talbot, rector of St. Paul's Episcopal Church, officiating.

Mr. Sweetman was born in New York city March 5, 1865, but for the past thirty years represented the Metropolitan Insurance Company in this city, serving actively up to four weeks ago, although long since entitled to retirement.
