#### **Was Veteran Employe of Washington Terminal Company**

James Stafford Taylor, veteran employe of the Washington Terminal Company, died Saturday at his residence, 1116 1st street, following an illness of several months. He was sixty-nine years old.

Mr. Taylor had been connected with the Pennsylvania railroad and the Washington Terminal for the past fifty-two years, entering the employe of the Pennsylvania at the age of seventeen as a brakeman. He was promoted and held the position of assistant yardmaster for twenty-three years. He was recently retired.

Funeral services will be held at his late residence tomorrow afternoon at 2 o'clock. Surviving him are three daughters, Mrs. James Much, Mrs. Frank Horan and Mrs. Edward Handy, and three sons, William, Raymond and Mallun Taylor.
