Col. Sydney Taylor Dies At 92; In Army 44 Years

Col. Sydney N Taylor, 92, retired Army officer and native of Washington, died yesterday at his home, 7208 Blair road N.W.

Col. Taylor was commissioned a second lieutenant in the 4th Artillery in 1867 and was retired September 6, 1911, after 44 years active service. He served as assistant adjutant general of the Army from 1901 to 1904.

Col. Taylor was born in the District May 21, 1849. A son, Edward G. Taylor, U.S.A., retired, resides in Haymarket, Va., and a daughter, Mrs. Taylor Morrison, lives here.
