Dies After Brief Illness

C.W. Thayer, War Department Employe, Was Born in Canada

Charles W. Thayer, an employe of the cable division of the War Department, died at his home, 311 East Capitol street, late yesterday afternoon, following a brief illness.

Mr. Thayer was a native of Canada where he was born at Georgetown, September 28, 1864, but he has been a resident of Washington at various times during the past thirty years.
