Alfred H. Thomas, 67, Dies At His Home

Alfred Holmead Thomas, sixty-seven years old and a lifelong resident of Washington, died at his home, 3638 Warder street northwest, early today.

Funeral services will be conducted at the late residence Friday afternoon at 2 o'clock. Rev. Dr. George F. Dudley, pastor of St. Stephen's Episcopal Church, will officiate. Interment will be in the Congressional cemetery.

Mr. Thomas, for thirty-five years had charge of all outgoing and incoming money and securities for the United States Treasury. He was retired three years ago.

The B.B. French Lodge, No. 15, F.A.A.M., of which Mr. Thomas was a member, will have charge of the funeral arrangements.

He is survived by his wife and two children, M. Edna and Alfred H. Thomas, jr. The latter is now in Milwaukee.
