Death of a Steamboat Man

Mr. William H. Thomas, a well-known citizen of South Washington, died at his residence on 11th street, South Washington, yesterday, after a long illness. Mr. Thomas came here from Alexandria many years ago, and for some twenty years was a prominent steamboat man; previous to the war running as the mate of the Southern mail steamer Mount Vernon, to Aquia Creek. He was a member of Eastern Lodge of Odd Fellows, who are attending the funeral this afternoon, with Onondaga Tribe of Red Men, headed by Heald's Band.
