Mrs. Thompson, 25-Year Employe At Georgetown U.

When she was there, the cafeteria was where a boy would stop for a free sandwich - or some sympathy, if that was what he needed. She helped many students get through the tough years by giving them all their meals.

Employes at the schools still remember the time a graduate sent Mrs. Thompson and \$800 check to pay for the meals she had given him over three years. She would not cash the check.

After she retired the Dental School filled the cafeteria room with food vending machines.

She leaves one sister, Gertrude L. Potts of Kent Village, Md., and many nieces and nephews.
