### **Former Capitol Mailman Expires**

Freeman Grant Thompson, veteran Washington letter carrier, with 40 years' service, who had a wide acquaintance among Senators and Representatives, gained while carrying mail at the Capitol years ago, died at his home, 222 Ninth street southeast, Thursday midnight. Death was due to cerebral hemorrhage.

Mr. Thompson, who was 65 years old, was a lifelong resident of this city. In recent years he had carried mail in Southeast Washington.

He is survived by his widow, Mrs. Emma J. Thompson; a son, George E. Thompson; two daughters, Mrs. W.A. Jenkins and Mrs. Mary A. Heinbuch, and seven grandchildren. He also leaves a sister, Mrs. Maude Finley of Ellensburg, Wash.

Funeral services will be conducted in the Grace Baptist Church, Ninth street and South Carolina avenue southeast, Monday afternoon at 2 o'clock. Rev. F.W. Johnson, pastor, will officiate. Interment will be in Congressional Cemetery.
