Funeral of Ruth Virginia Thompson

The remains of little Ruth Virginia Thompson, the youngest daughter of Prof. and Mrs. Millard F. Thompson, were laid away in Congressional cemetery last evening. The casket, banked to overflowing with beautiful floral tributes, was borne by six of the students of the senior dental class of National University, clad in the conventional robes and caps of student life.

The funeral services were conducted by Rev. D.W. Skellenger, pastor of the Sixth Presbyterian Church, with which the family has long been connected. The Sunday school classmates of the deceased were present in a body, singing several hymns during the services.
