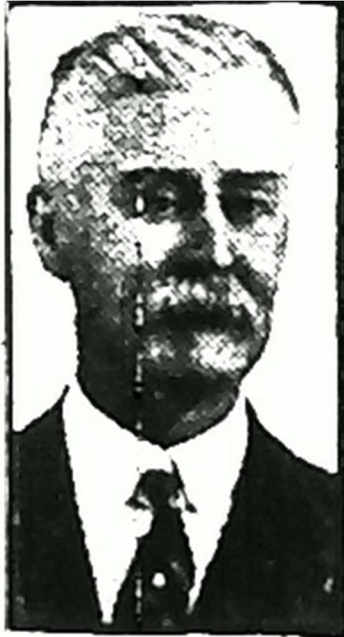


## Alexander Dallas Tucker

### **Alexander Tucker, Native of City, Die**

#### **Funeral Services to Be Held Monday for Lifelong Resident of District**

Alexander Dallas Tucker, 85, of 1346 Park road, a lifelong resident of the District died at the home early today after a long illness. Funeral services will be held at the Hines funeral home at 1 p.m. Monday. Burial will be in the Congressional Cemetery.

Mr. Tucker was born October 1, 1850, the son of John H. and Sarah McPherson Tucker, in Southwest Washington. The Tucker family was among the first residents in that part of the city, then known as the Island. For several years he was connected with the Alonzo O. Bliss Properties, retiring several years ago following a slight stroke. At one time he was associated with Albert Gleason, the contractor who played a major part in the development of Washington Heights and Chevy Chase.

Mr. Tucker is survived by his widow, Mrs. Mariam Mankin Tucker, and two children, Miss M. Ethel Tucker, 1346 Park road, and Edwin D. Tucker of New York.

Mr. Tucker was a member of the Association of Oldest Inhabitants and of the Society of Natives.
