Collision Kills Cyclist

Frederick E. Turner, about forty-two years old, of Ballston, Va., was killed today when the motorcycle on which he was riding collided with a motor truck at 13th and D streets.

According to witnesses, Turner was riding east on D street and the motor truck, driven by Basil W. Gray, 1219 Potomac street, for the General Auto Truck Company, was proceeding north on 13th street. The motorcycle, according to the witnesses, struck a rear wheel of the truck. Turner was taken to Emergency Hospital and pronounced dead.
